#### **DURATION**

1 year. September to August or January to December 1125 hours divided into 3 modules

#### **WORK EXPERIENCE**

Each student must carry out a minimum of 25 hours external work experience outside of the school timetable.

## REQUIREMENTS 19 years old A good lavel

18 years old. A good level of English. A clear vocation for hairdressing, and a mature and focussed attitude.





- (1) As contained in Directive 2005/36 / EC of the European Parliament and Council, this course corresponds to the level established by the European Union. It is valid in the entire community territory and in all those countries that have agreed to accept these standards as accreditation to practice the professions of hairdressing and aesthetics within its borders. These include 33 states of the United States, Puerto Rico, Guam, Canada, New Zealand, Australia and South Africa.
- (2) These rates are valid up until 31.12.2019. As of this date all amounts are subject to the corresponding annual increase. Kit prices are subject to changes in market prices and taxes. The price of the kit could vary if the price of any of the items that make it up increases. The amount will always be correct as of the date of matriculation or application for registration.
- (3) The General Law for the Defense of Consumers and Users establishes that the applicant has 7 working days after matriculation and the purchase of the kit (if applicable) to exercise their right of revocation, and to receive a refund of the amounts paid. After the deadline indicated, the contract will be considered firm and the amounts paid will not be returnable.
- (4) Fees paid may be transferred to other types of training and under no circumstances refundable. During a one-year period, the balance in favor of the student may be used to participate in any other course taught by BHA.
- (5) The material included in the Kit covers most of the material needed on this course. The school does not however rule out the possible need to purchase of extra material during the course.
- (6) The matriculation fee must be paid separately from the training fees. The matriculation fee is not included in the course price, and must be paid in order to undertake training in BHA.
